As you are aware that training is one of the essential component for capacity building of Human Resources. The Central Bureau of Health Intelligence (CBHI), under the aegis of Directorate General of Health Services (Dte. GHS) regularly conducts following short term Orientation Training Programmes through its various Training Centers for medical and para-medical officers & staffs of hospitals / health institutions under Central / State Governments and Public Sector Undertakings.

- i. Health Information Management for Officers
- ii. Health Information Management for Para-Medical Personnel
- iii. Family of International Classification (ICD-11 & ICF) for Para-Medical Personnel
- iv. Training of Trainers (ToT) on Family of International Classification (ICD-11) for Medical Officer.
- v. Training on Medical Record & Information Management System (MRIM) for Para – Medical Personnel.
- vi. Training of Trainers (TOT) on International Classification of Functioning, Disability & Health (ICF) for Medical Officer.

Besides the aforementioned trainings, CBHI also conducts 12 Months Training Programme for Medical Record Officers (MRO) at Safdarjung Hospital, New Delhi / JIPMER, Puducherry and 6 Months Training Programme for Medical Record Technicians (MRT) at the Training Centers of Safdarjung and Dr. RML Hospitals, New Delhi / JIPMER, Puducherry and RIMS, Ranchi for which communications are issued, separately.

2. In this connection, please find enclosed herewith the schedule of **Short Term** Training Programmes to be conducted during **2024-25** at various Training Centers (TC) of CBHI as **Annexure - I**. The details of all the Training Centers of CBHI viz. Name, Address, Tel. No. and E-mail etc. as **Annexure - II**. The prescribed Application Form at **Annexure - III**. The application form may also be downloaded from the website www.cbhidghs.nic.in.

3. The out-stationed sponsored in-service candidates (regular Govt. employees) for these **Short Term Training Programmes** will be paid entitled TA / DA as per extant provisions of Govt. of India. The period of training will be treated as '**On duty**'. The local sponsored in-service candidates will not be entitled for any TA /DA.

4. The contractual and non-government candidates may also apply for these **Short Term Training Programmes**. However, their candidature will be considered subject to the availability of seats after selecting candidates working in Govt. and they will not be entitled for any TA / DA and honorarium. The person working / deployed, on voluntary basis, in any organization will not be considered for any of aforementioned training Programmes.

5. The duly recommended application(s) of eligible candidate(s), complete in all respects, may please be sent to the concerned Training Centre of FSUs (under jurisdiction of which the State / UT falls) as per Training Schedule, at least 30 days before the commencement of the respective Training Programme, as indicated against each Programme in **Annexure-I**. The selected candidates and their sponsoring organizations will be informed, accordingly, well before the commencement of the Programme(s). **The selected candidate(s) will be required to report to The Training Centre for the concerned Training Programmes as per schedule. In case, the candidate does not report in the forenoon of the first day of the training Programme, he / she will not be permitted to join the Programme.**

6. These Orientation Training Programmes are essential for improving and strengthening the Health Information System and for promoting use of uniform ICD-11 & ICF Codes for morbidity, mortality, functions, disability & related health aspects at all levels of health / medical care system. Your cooperation is solicited for ensuring full utilization of these training facilities for strengthening of health information eco-system in all Medical and Public Health Institutions / Organizations.

7. It is, therefore, requested to circulate the Training Calendar among various health care institutions / hospitals of the Central & State Government, the Public Sector Undertakings and registered Non-Govt. healthcare establishments involved in medical and health fields in your State / UT so as to ensure maximum participation in the upcoming training programme.
